



### Keenan Recycling Installs VCU's For Aberdeen City Bio Waste

Keenan Recycling, based at New Deer, Aberdeenshire have for many years been windrow composting the garden waste supplied by SITA as part of their contract with Aberdeen City Council.

The company processed over 25,000 tonnes of this waste in 2008. However, to meet diversion of biodegradable waste from landfill targets, Aberdeen City Council has commenced the collection of food waste, co-collected with the garden waste.

Due to the regulations regarding the composting of food waste Keenan Recycling needed to select a technology that could meet stringent processing requirements.

Having been selected for funding from the WRAP organics program Keenan Recycling completed a full due diligence evaluation of available technologies for approval.

The company decided to go forward with VCU Europa for the delivery of a plant which met their site requirements and was fully proven.

Delivery, installation and commissioning of the 12 VCU™ chambers has been completed and SVS full certification to the ABP regs achieved. Keenans have successfully bid for further WRAP funding, with an additional 6 VCU™ chambers scheduled for installation 1st quarter 2010.
